BEAR HOLIDAY TWO settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, rallied, led a furlong out and held, driving. SEAWATCH, in range, chased late turn, launched a furious charge but hung late. SNEAKY MONEY raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, rallied outside and got up up for third. THORNWOOD ROAD settled off the pace, closed on the backstretch, stalked along the rail on the turn and finished gamely. MASTER NOBLE stalked the pace in hand, chased from midturn and evened out midstretch. WESTDALE WARRIOR, in range by the 1/2, bid into the far turn, dueled, shook clear into

the stretch but was headed a furlong out and chased to the end. MATTER OF HASTE set a pressured pace, dueled on the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. BARE IS BEST, in range early, dropped back on the far turn, was hustled along but lacked a rally. SILENT HUMOR stalked the pace, backed away at the far turn, was hustled along and also had no rally. JUST PAUL settled off the pace, chased on the turn but never reached contention. THE BEAR VOW raced off the pace, saved ground and lacked a rally. SEA BANK pressed the pace early, backed away at the far turn and tired.
