PAPIAMENTO sprinted clear, set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn, drove clear entering the stretch and held sway under steady handling. RACKMAN settled off the pace, closed outside rivals on the turn then finished under a determined drive. HESA BIG DUDE stalked early then forced the pace on the backstretch, dueled on the turn, gave way late turn and finished evenly through the stretch. HIGHLAND BAY settled off the pace, chased late turn then finished evenly. QUICK TURNOVER stalked the pace in hand, was squeezed back midturn and checked sharply then evened out. MYTH MASTER, rated in range, saved ground then lacked a strong late response. MAJOR PRODUCTION settled off the pace, chased late turn but never reached contention. ORION'S SONG settled off the pace, was roused late turn but lacked a closing response. FANTASTIC PROSPECT settled in midpack, was steadied midturn, chased into the stretch and evened out. OPEN ICE HIT, in touch, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch.
