CALL TO FAITH stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn, rallied gamely inside the leader and got up late, driving. SUBTLE AUTHORITY dueled, gained a short lead on the turn, turned back GLADIATORS SHOT late turn, shook clear into the stretch then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. MR MCGREGOR stalked the pace, chased three to five-wide on the turn and was all out through the stretch. INHERITED, off slowly, settled in midpack, chased two to four-wide on the turn then finished gamely outside. GLADIATORS SHOT dueled, forced the issue on the turn, failed with a bid late turn and gave way grudgingly through the stretch. TYPICAL DAYDREAM, off slowly, was hustled along the rail and two-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. BIG EFFORT broke in the air, raced from off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. DUBLIN NIGHTS broke in the air, raced in midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. PHIL THE FOX, fractious just prior to the start, left without his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
