TINY BEAR, off slowly, settled off the pace, closed along the rail on the turn, drove to the lead midstretch and widened under steady pressure. ALPHA AWAY stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and raced gamely to the wire. ROCKET COLLEEN forced the issue, led into the turn, shook clear, set the pace, was passed midstretch and gave way. THEOGONY, off slowly, settled off the pace, angled out sharply late turn, came seven-wide into the stretch and rallied angling ward through the final furlong. CHARTIER raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. MADAME G, away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch but was not a threat. NO FINESSE, in range, dropped back on the turn and lacked a rally. SUMMER WEATHER forced the pace, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch. DAN'S DEE DEE set a pressured pace, was headed near the turn, dropped back and tired. ROYAL SPUN, in range early, faded on the turn and lacked a closing response.
