JUMP TO THE CHASE well placed early, rallied and angled out in the upper stretch, split horses and prevailed late under strong handling. NOGGIN dueled for the early lead, gained a clear lead on the second turn, gave way grudgingly through the lane when hooked. GRAND DIMANCHE contended throughout but lacked a late response. DODGE THE BULLET well placed, had no rally and went evenly. BOBBYN BOUIE allowed to settle, had a middle move on the inside, then faltered in the stretch. HANG ON SLEWPY vied for lead and tired on the second turn. RIDERS ON THESTORM was no threat. FULL FLEDGE RUMOR was outrun. OKIE BREEZE was no factor. VANTASTIC showed little.
