BRANDONS HOT SAUCE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. JACKSON GEORGE well placed from between foes, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could not reach the winner. MAJOR TUNE forced the early pace from between foes, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. RAY O ACK far back early, advanced outside entering the drive and finished well. COPENHAGEN WAVE could only improve position. DOC CASEY could only pass tired ones. OUR ONLY HOPE was no factor. OCCUPATIONALHAZARD was no threat. IN A BIND chased the early pace and tired. B J'S PARTY DICE had a steady fade. DOS LUMBRE dueled from the inside and gave way.
