CRAFTY TALENT contested the pace inside from the early going, floated out some entering the lane, fought gamely and held on. MOM'S LUCKY RIBBON forwardly placed just off the inside, gained an opening two wide on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, drifted out briefly midstretch, was corrected, closed well but too late. T SPARKS pressed from outside, brushing with DIAMOND MASTER nearing the turn, gradually angled in looking for room through the bend, came to challenged for the lead along the rail in the stretch but hung through the waning yards. HOT WALKER void of speed, though hustled along from outside, could only pass a few tired ones in the stretch. RASCALS BACK AGAIN displayed early speed from path three and brushed with DIAMOND MASTER as he began to tire midway on the bend. DIAMOND MASTER in close quarters between rivals nearing the turn, brushed with RASCALS BACK AGAIN while passing that one from outside on the turn but wore down through the lane. CEE CEE'S BOY stayed off the inside and showed little.
