FRED HENRY dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged entering the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was clear late while under steady urging. GEORGE A. well placed from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. CHIEFY LOOK chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive and finished well but too late. EIGHTY NINER forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. I B RED E well placed from between foes, made a bid entering the drive but flattened out late. JOY ON BROADWAY could only pass tired ones. MOUNTAIN GULCH was no factor. ZAC SCHILLER was no threat. THE COUNTRYS BEST forced the early pace outside and tired. FLY BO FLY showed little. RESERVE THE GOLD dueled from the outside and gave way. RAGGEDY HOBO was bumped at the start and lost rider.
