MIKA'S TOPGUN broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to be forward entering the drive, dueled with DR SWIFT through the drive, gained a clear margin deep stretch the was all out to last. HENRY SUNSHINE unhurried early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded entering the drive and just missed. DR SWIFT up close early from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, dueled with the winner through the drive, drifted in mid stretch then shortened stride late. SNOW RISK pressed the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. DEADWOOD DESPERADO went evenly. PLEASUREMAGHNET was no factor. DRILL STEM had a steady fade. MADE IN OKLAHOMA was always outrun.
