DAT DOE DILBERT dueled from the outside for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn, responded when challenged entering the drive, dueled through the drive and was just up late. GROOM stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid along the rail but was outfinished. SKEETER SLEW well placed from the inside, altered outside entering the turn, made a bid to duel through the drive but was outfinished. HOPE'S LEAP forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the drive but could not sustain the effort. TRULY TRULY TRULY up close early from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. ANTLES SKIPAWAY could only improve position. LUCKY REWARD chased the early pace and tired. COLLEGE DAZ was no factor. PLAIN CAT had little interest. BIG CASH DEAL was never close. LONDON SWING dueled from the inside and gave way.
