THREEOLOCKFRIDAY was well placed throughout, rallied in the upper stretch and saved ground, drew clear late, driving. DAPPLED dueled on the lead the entire trip, was outfinished late but was clearly second best. STEVEN'S MARK allowed to settle, had a mild rally while no threat. TOM'S LEGACY dueled for the lead and weakened in mid stretch. SHEIK OF WAGONER never far back, had no late bid. ABSENT FRIEND slow early, did not threaten. A MAN was through after a half. MEASUREMENT vied for the early lead and tired. SUPERSTONE showed little. BUBBA WINS well placed for a half, dropped back.
