Footnotes

EVADE stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure to duel through the drive with ALERIC and outfinished that one the final yards. ALERIC up close early from the outside, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged with the winner through the drive but was outfinished. FORESTRY STEEL broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. GRAPES TO WINE pressed the early pace inside but was no threat late. JUMP TO THE CHASE was no factor. HERESYASIGN had a steady fade.
