TOMAHAWK CREEK broke sharp from between foes to gain the early margin, widen the effort entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was never threatened while lightly roused. RED PETE chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but was no match while clearly second best. HOLLYWOOD ICE forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid but could only gain the show. NORMANDY SHORE pressed the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. MOMMA'S BADNEWS chased the early pace and tired. FIFTH DATE had a steady fade. STEAL YOUR FACE was always outrun.
