RAY O ACK void early speed, between horses stretch, best of others. HEAVENLY SHILOH unhurried early, 4 wide stretch, flattened out. SPODIE ODIE void early speed, passed tiring rivals. ALERT THE GIRLS stalked pace, gave way. SIR KIPLING allowed to settle, faded. WAYA RAGE well placed, tired. FLY BO FLY duelled, stopped.
