SILVER SHAMAN was unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch and circled the field, closed deternienly and was up in the final jumps. TWO JAYS SECRET stalked the pace, rallied on the second turn, dueled through the stretch and just missed. SPECIAL ELECTION raced in the second flight, closed willingly through the stretch. OKLAHOMA RISING stalked the pace and dueled on the lead, was outfinished late. DA BADA BING raced between horses and was no threat. CHIVAS ROYAL stalked the pace and dueled on the lead, then gave way in mid stretch. PASS THE BISCUITS was never a threat. MAJOR BUCKS set the early pace and stopped in the stretch.
