Footnotes

BULLARA close up early while outside rivals, crept closer entering the second turn, challenged for the lead mid turn, gained command and was well clear while kept to task. WW CONQUISTADOR unhurried early, advanced inside up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive but was no match while clearly second best. THREE PARK NIGHT outrun early, steadily advanced inside up the backstretch, responded along the rail entering the drive and finished well. CIRCUSTOWN CAT forced the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. SMOKING KIP was no factor. WILL HORN went evenly. STATICE was no threat. MAKE THE GRADE had little interest. ASHE'S CAT set the early pace and gave way. GOLLY WALLY stumbled at the start and lost rider.
