LADY EMMAJAY never far back, closed willingly through the stretch and was second best. CHEROKEE GODDESS allowed to settle, rallied in the stretch and finished well. WHY POLLY WHY dueled for the early lead, weakened in the stretch. HARRIMANS MAE LADY wide early, did not threaten. WANDOROUS had good position, lacked a late response. KINSLEE A well placed early, had no late bid. DU GOOD BABY vied for the lead for a half, tired in the stretch. LACIE'S BONUS slow early, was outrun. KATHY'S PROPERLADY was no factor. SIENNA STORM was through early.
