Footnotes

KIT PARANOID rated from outside, weaved in then back out to improve position in traffic on the turn, came widest into the lane, altered out some to stay clear of BRASSY TOUCH midstretch, gained a very narrow advantage just inside the sixteenth marker and held on. ABBY'S POLICY prominent between horses from the beginning, angled out four wide for a clear path on the bend, altered in some midstretch when her path was taken, split weakening rivals with a sixteenth left, fought gamely to the wire but had to settle for second best. BRASSY TOUCH kept close between rivals, was three wide taking the turn, vied for the lead outside KIT KAT CODE in the stretch, drifted out some with a furlong left, held a straight path the last sixteenth but slowly yielded. KIT KAT CODE set a pressured pace off the rail but inside her foes, was just off the inside taking the turn, battled through the stretch but did not have enough left the final sixteenth. FIDDLE PLAYER was soon well back, swung out on the turn and passed some tired ones in the stretch without threatening. GOLDEN ENCORE soon filled the opening along the rail on the backstretch, saved ground through the turn then gave way for the drive. BROOKE ACADEMY in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, gave way just off the rail on the bend.
