LINE PIPER good position between horses, gave way. REBEL ROOY dueled, faded. SERVER EIGHTY ONE unhurried early, flattened out. FASHION BOY stalked pace, tired. PHARAWAY TRAIN off slowly, improved position. DOWNANDOUBLE no speed, showed little. INDY FEVER no threat, failed to menace. BITTER PILL brief speed, stopped. TIP OF FIRE pulled up turn, did not finish.
