CANNON CLASS duled from the outside early, dropped back slightly entering the turn, remained forward entering the drive, responded when asked and wore down I'M HOLLYWOOD the final yards. I'M HOLLYWOOD duled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn but could not keep pace. OVERLY TRICKY well placed from between foes, responded entering the drive and was gaining late. LEAD ROPE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn and finished well. GLORYS LEGEND up close early from the inside, had nothing left for the drive. E'S RIDE pressed the early pace from between foes but had no late response. D C GIT N GO went evenly. YAHARA J had little impact. NETTIE BOY was no threat. WHATYAWAITINON was no factor. DEAL 'M HIGH had a steady fade. ALUMNI FOOL trailed throughout.
