NOTIFY dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn with ENCHATIVEMEDALIST, put that one away entering the drive, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. ENCHATIVEMEDALIST dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the turn with the winner but could not keep pace. RUN OFF RIVER outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, split rivals upper stretch and was gaining late. RUNAWAY OKIE forced the early pace inside but had nothing left. ISLE OF MAN chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out. ARTIC HEAT forced the early pace outside and tired. FINANCIALLY SECURE was never close.
