FIZZY POP stalked the early pace, rallied at the quarter pole, drew off through the stretch while being ridden out. ALERIC was allowed to settle, rallied in the stretch, could not reach the winner but was second best. I ALBERT allowed to settle, had a mild rally while no threat. ALMAGNUS never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. KING GULCH unhurried early, was never a threat. GUINNESS CHARLIE set the pace for three quarters, weakened in the stretch. OUST was no factor. SPECIAL ELECTION had good position until the second turn, gave way in the stretch.
