SUPER SIPHONIC dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive with DIXIELOOM HEAT, brushed with that one mid stretch and outfinished his rival the final yards. DIXIELOOM HEAT dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled with the winner through the drive, was brushed mid stretch and outfinished. SOONER SPEED chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, altered outside and was gaining late. ROCK SOLID ALIBI chased the early pace but had nothing left. CATHYDAVID'SDANCER dueled from the inside for the early lead, was steadied mid turn, drifted out and finished evenly late. HOT LINK went evenly. TOMMY AND JOHNNY was no factor. CHIEF CORNERSTONE had a steady fade.
