UNOME LODE unhurried early, rallied four wide in the upper stretch, closed fast and drew clear. RARE OKIE contended throughout, finished willingly and was second best. SPRING BLUFF allowed to settle, rallied through the stretch and closed willingly. KICKER CAT pressed the pace, lacked a late response and went evenly. UNCLE RIP duelled early, gained a clear lead around the turn, faltered in late stretch. CHIEF TWO SPOTS allowed to settle early, had a mild bid late. TOP EMPLOYEE pressed the pace, faded in the stretch. CEEYA SAM was no factor. STORM PASTUM never far back, lacked a late response. DEMON'S DEVILLE was no threat. JADED LIONEL was outrun.
