CLEAVERS HILL was away alertly and set the pace, remained clear in mid stretch, bore out late causing YOGA to steady, then lasted. YOGA never far back, rallied four wide in the upper stretch, was gaining and to steady late when CLEAVERS HILL bore out. HOPE'S LEAP pressed the pace, needed more late but finished willingly. SPIRIT UNBROKEN pressed the pace, had no late bid. MANDATE MAKER well placed early, rallied at the quarter pole, then failed to sustain his bid. ILLUSIVE GOLD was no factor. MEDICINE HORSE MAN flashed brief foot and tired. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of YOGA claimed foul against the rider of CLEAVERS HILL for inference in late stretch. After viewing the tape the stewards disqualified CLEAVERS HILL and placed him second for inference in late stretch.
