SILVER PAYDAY stalked the pace, rallied at the quarter pole, gained a clear lead in mid stretch and lasted under strong handling. BETCHA LICKEM raced in the second flight, rallied in the upper stretch, angled out seven wide, closed fast and was gaining. HELLA BELLA pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, weakened in late stretch. ACCUSTOM well placed, lacked late a response and went evenly. CANDY NECKLACE contended but needed more. HUG vied for lead and tired. MAG BASKET pressed the pace, then faded. PLANETARY FERRY set the early pace and tired. SIMPLY ANGELINA was no factor. FRANK'S CUP OF TEA was no threat. VICTORIAN RIDGE was outrun. FIFI MUSIC showed little.
