Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of entry. This race will be limited to 12 starters. MISS NATALIE up close early from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out late to last. LESLEY BE JUDGED stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and was getting to the winner. MISS DAISY DO dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, held a forward position entering the drive and but could not match strides. CAGEY LITTLE GIRL dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn but could not keep pace. SHESAUNA chased the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. GARBU AND SHE was no real factor. WHENISLIFEAHOLIDAY never threatened. STRAWBERRY CHASE had little impact. FANCI CANDI was finished early.
