**Footnotes**

SENIOR ISAAC stalked the early pace and saved ground, angled out seven wide in the upper stretch, drew off late while full of run. DU HOPE dueled for the lead, was no match for the winner late but was second best. SUM MAN stalked the pace, had a mild bid from the outside no threat. WHIRLING CREST dueled for the lead, then weakened in the stretch. ROCKS A'ROLLIN allowed to settle, failed to menace. BLAZEN SUMMER was no threat. SOCIAL CHIEF was no factor. DARFOUR dueled and tired in the stretch. DUANES LITLETADPOL was never a threat. SPRING BLUFF was outrun. CATCONQUERSALL slow early, was always outrun. WATERSTORM showed little.
