ESAU dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. QUATORZE KID chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, veered in mid stretch then could only hold the place. OUI OUI JAZZY allowed to settle early, advanced inside, responded to pressure and was gaining late. POWER BALL SLEW unhurried early, advanced outside, made a bid and finished well. ROAD TO RIO could only improve position. CAPTURE THE FLAG dueled from the outside and tired. BUILTLIKEABRICK chased the early pace and tired. DOS LUMBRE had little interest. A BID FAREWELL was never close. PROBABLY TRU was finished early and distanced.
