HANDSOME BILL unhurried early, had a steady advance and finished well. CHIVAS ROYAL well placed, had a mild bid. SELECTED set the pace and dueled on the lead from the inside, weakened in the stretch. ALLEGED DEVIL never far back, went evenly. ADIOS KIP failed to menace. LOUIE DE PLUS was through after a half. MAJOR BUCKS was outrun.
