GATOR HATER stalked the pace inside, moved out three wide at the quarter pole to rally and drew off under a steady drive. I'M OUTA HERE stalked the pace inside, then improved position late outside. TOP EMPLOYEE was clear early but couldn't last. Q AND A improved position late. I'M FEELING LUCKY raced evenly. NO SHUG TONIGHT stalked the early pace, bid at the half-mile pole, then gave way in the stretch. CHIEF TWO SPOTS faded. VISION OF PARADISE was not a factor. CHIEF JUDGE was eased late. PHONE BILL pulled up just past the half-mile pole and was vanned off.
