**Footnotes**

HERE COMES NICE up close early from the outside, tracked the pace up the backstretch, remained in a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and wore down DANCE WITH HARGETT the final furlong. DANCE WITH HARGETT dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, remained in a battle through the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole but was caught the final strides. MIZLOU stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail and had good energy late. DREAMS ON THE WIND outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well but too late. ROCKDALECONNECTION forced the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out late. AFLEETMOVINANGEL went evenly. QUEEN'S ISSUE dueled from the inside and tired. BLUE PYRAMID chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. ALLEVIATE was no factor. KIM'S WINENROSES was no threat.
