GEORGE A. broke sharp from the outside to gain the early margin, widen the effort entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. RUNAWAY PEPPER well placed from the inside, steadily advanced entering the drive, responded but was no match while clearly second best. ROBBITYME pressed the early pace from the inside, was steadied entering the drive, recovered to come again for the show. CRUIZEN YUZOOM forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward but had nothing left. STUNT JUNKY chased the early pace outside and tired. IAMJUSTACOUNTRYBOY went evenly. RAISE YOUR BENCH chased the early pace outside but had no late response. FACT IS IM AWESOME was forced wide into the turn and was no factor. GOOD LUCK CHARM was no threat. ROYAL FABLE had little interest. EYE OF SYCLONE was never close. MR SLEW BAR drifted out into the first turn, carried a rival out and was outrun.
