MAE'S RACER allowed to settle, inside stretch, passed tiring rivals. TRITICALE off slowly, improved position. TIMOTHY TEN FOUR close up, gave way. FUNINTHERAIN unhurried early, evenly. NORTHERN BULLET well placed, faded. WHOSTHATADMIRAL dueled, tired. DRB'S CRYSTAL BALL off slowly, no threat.
