HAYMOW BOB pressed the pace three wide and was up late under a drive. KICKEM DALTON pressed the pace inside, bid on the far turn, then was outfinished. SUN CAN RUN pressed the pace between rivals, then gave way late. BARRON DALTON pressed the pace outside, then lacked a late bid. BOLD STANDARD and TICKET TO PARIS raced evenly. GOLD HIT stalked the pace five wide, then lacked a late bid. EMMA'S CAT was not a factor. LEGACY OF PRINCESS was through early. MR. DEPUTY was off awkwardly and was rank, and raced well back.
