EDPLICIT broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, widen the effort up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole and was clear late while kept to task. JUMP TO THE CHASE unhurried early, advanced inside entering the second turn, altered outside but could not reach the winner. GOLDEN CHAPEL pressed the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. DOCTOR CAL chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. TO HEIR IS HUMAN well placed from the inside, had no late response. AISLE TWO was never close. WEBCAST was finished after a half.
