YOGA stalked the pace three wide, rallied at the top of the stretch and was up late under a steady drive. ALFRED KENT led off the rail, then couldn't hold off the winner. HOPE'S LEAP rallied five wide at the quarter pole, then hung in the drive. CLEAVERS HILL pressed the early pace along the rail, then yielded late. TWICE AS BAD and MANDATE MAKER were not factors. MUSICAL MADDY pressed the early pace before giving way.
