SLEWMASTER broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and proved much the best while kept to task. SMILES AHEAD unhurried early, advanced outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. EVANSVILLE STORM allowed to settle early, advanced inside, responded entering the drive but could only gain the show. BANKIN ON FUN well placed from the inside, forced the early pace up the backstretch, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. QUATORZE KID forced the early pace from the outside and tired in the drive. BROADWAY BILLY was no factor. HIGHWAY FIFTYFOUR pressed the early pace outside and tired. FOREVER SLEW flashed early speed and tired.
