Footnotes

OKIE LIMIT broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, widen the effort entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and was much the best while kept to task. THE COUNTRYS BEST stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could not reach the winner. R C GOLD KIP forced the early pace from the inside, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. I'M HOLLYWOOD well placed from the inside, remained forward for the drive but had no late response. MR PEST could only improve position. PURISM was no factor. C THE STORM went evenly. LETHAL TRICK was no threat. BEAUASODA had little interest. COPENHAGEN WAVE was never close. SNOWS LAST CHANCE broke well, rushed up the inside, ducked out and lost rider.
