DEAL A KING led inside and drew off in the stretch under mild urging. RIGHT SQUALL saved ground, angled out five wide at the quarter pole, rallied but was too late. BIG CASH DEAL saved ground, then improved position late. BERNIES LEGACY stalked the pace inside, then gave way in the drive. SHERRI'S NICK pressed the pace, then couldn't match strides late. SOONER HEISMAN pressed the pace three wide for a half mile before fading in the drive. FLASH THE MONEY stalked the pace to the stretch before fading. Q P SLEW faded five wide. WAR WAGON and JARIN'S REPLY and NANCY'S BABY BOY were not factors.
