AISLE TWO stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, came off the rail entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was just in time. BOLD STANDARD dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole but was caught late. KILATES KISS pressed the early pace from the outside, dropped back slightly, responded to pressure and finished well. LOST MY MIND dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch but could not keep pace. CHIEF TWO SPOTS could only pass tired ones. CEE BAILEY ZOOM was off a step slow and raced evenly. MAKE THE GRADE had a steady fade. JAGAN was finished early.
