CHISHOLM TRAIL was quickly over to lead along the rail, went clear in the stretch and lasted under a mild drive. DEB'S EXPENSE ACC stalked the pace four wide, saved ground around the turn, angled out four wide and closed. ROCK SOLID ALIBI pressed the pace between rivals, then gave way late. POPEYE MUSIC saved ground, angled out five wide in the stretch but lacked a late bid. GUYS HILL pressed the pace three wide, then gave way in the drive. THUNDER CLUTCH was off awkwardly, raced five wide, then improved position while seven wide. PROUGH JOE and COLLEGE DAZ were not factors. PASTOR JOEL faded. HOT LINK bobbled at the start.
