OKLAHOMA NATURAL stalked the early pace from the inside, remained forward through the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, dueled with PACIFIC CALM through the drive and inched clear late. ALFRED KENT well placed from the inside, advanced entering the turn, made a bid along the rail and was just up for the place. PACIFIC CALM broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, held a clear margin entering the turn, dueled through the drive but could not keep pace. YOGA pressed the early pace from the inside, could only improve position. UNO DUCKSY was no factor. SILVER FLICKA was no threat. JAZZMANS DREAM had little interest. TAKEDOWN forced the early pace and tired. WHIRLING CREST had a steady fade. FORREST GUMP OK showed little.
