SAN SABA was away alertly, set the pace and led throughout, pressured into a duel down the stretch and gave way. SECRET WOODS headed the leader for three quarters, tired and gave way late. HANDSOME BILL was void of early speed, made a middle move picking up horses. FUN GUN was the early trailer, had a late rally and passed tiring rivals. H K'S VICTORY showed little. GRAND DIMANCHE stalked the pace, steadied on the backside, then no factor. SPECIAL ELECTION never a threat. TIZMET pressed the pace, stopped. YOU GIMME FEVER dull effort, eased.
