KIPSANDY close up, between horses, gained command stretch, driving. FANCY FELLOW unhurried early, 5 wide stretch, all out, second best. P L RIVER PRO allowed to settle, inside stretch, late bid. ALERT THE GIRLS off slowly, middle move, flattened out. ECONOMIC CONCERN set pace, inside, weakened. DOC CASEY well placed, between horses, failed to sustain bid. YAHARA J allowed to settle, faded. BIG TOMCAT unhurried early, evenly. CARSON'S CAL no threat, outrun. DID IT AGAIN allowed to settle, tired. SHAWNIEE well placed, stopped.
