BOBBY BE GOLD led inside, was challenged at the top of the stretch but drew off late under a steady drive. CHIEF ELLIS pressed the pace along the rail, bid at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. RAY O ACK pressed the pace between rivals, bid three wide at the three-sixteenths pole, but failed to sustain the bid. OKIE PROSPECT improved position late while four wide. PROBABLY TRU was unrushed early inside, angled out seven wide entering the stretch, bid and then faltered. ROAD TO RIO stalked the pace, bid five wide at the top of the stretch but faltered. MR PEST pressed three wide before giving way in the drive. ONE BUD TO GO was jostled about at the start and trailed the field.
