HUFF DADDY vied three wide, bid and drew off in midstretch under a steady drive. PURE PANICK was unrushed early, bid six wide at the top of the stretch but couldn't get close to the winner. DEE INDY GO vied inside, then gave way late while lugging out in the drive. CAPE TOWN HALO stalked the pace five wide, rallied at the top of the stretch, but faltered. CHASIN THE SUNDOWN raced evenly inside. CHIEF TWO SPOTS stalked the pace between rivals, then faded in the stretch. PICK YOUR TARGET saved ground to no avail. NO SHUG TONIGHT vied between rivals to the stretch then gave way. DROP KICK was not a factor. WHEN I SHINE vied early four wide before fading.
