PIONEER WAY bore out at the start, bothering rivals, stalked the pace four wide, bid at the half mile pole and drew off in the drive. CHUNKS A HUNK vied along the rail but couldn't last. KINDA LIKER vied between rivals, then gave way in the drive. HENRYETTA O. K. pressed the early pace before giving way. BLAZING RIVER faded. SAUCY KITTY was bumped hard at the start. KATHY'S PROPERLADY was bumped hard at the start and was knocked off stride. TWO BUCKS A SONG stalked the pace for a half mile before fading. SEEKING GREAT WINE stumbled at the start and lost the rider, then chased the field to the backstretch.
