Footnotes

BEGG'S was bumped at the start, stalked the pace inside, angled out five wide at the quarter pole and was up late in a drive. TWO JAYS SECRET stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, then couldn't hold off the winner. ONE ROOM SCHOOL stumbled at the start, pressed the pace, bid, then couldn't hold off the closers. DAPHNE'S MAGIC saved ground and offered a mild late bid. SMART 'N SALTY was bumped at the start, bid five wide at the top of the stretch but faltered. PITTON'S ROAD led inside before giving way on the turn. CITY BOY stalked the early pace five wide, then faded. CATO was not a factor.
