RIGHT SQUALL stalked the pace three wide, rallied at the quarter pole, brushed the leader and drew off. BIG CASH DEAL saved ground, angled out four wide at the quarter pole, rallied but was not a match for the winner. BY BY BARON was clear early, then was brushed by the winner at the top of the stretch and gave way. A RIDER'S OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED. ANTLES SKIPAWAY stalked the pace between rivals before fading in the drive. PROBABLY TRU faded. MADE IN OKLAHOMA improved position late. PAYROLL pressed the early pace. CHASIN THE GIRLS was jostled in the early going. ORCHID'SLASTSTAND and BRANDED MAN were not factors.
